






# **INTERNATIONAL WORKER CONNECTIONS**

# **Third Culture Kid (TCK) Adoption**

Some very important people in our Central District family are our TCKs—third culture kids—formerly known as MKs (missionary kids). Our purpose is to ensure that every one of these children is "adopted" by a church who will pray for them regularly and demonstrate love in creative, long-distance ways. We want our IWs to know that we're not only praying for them and the ministry God has called them to, but that we are also caring for their children.

# CREATIVE ACCESS COUNTRY (CAC) WORKER RESTRICTED ACCESS – "RED" COUNTRY WORKER GUIDELINES

Alliance International Workers in Creative or Restricted Access Countries risk having their visas revoked, being expelled, or worse, when their identities and locations are discovered. Please follow these guidelines carefully. Be aware that anything you communicate can be placed on the Internet by anyone who can scan or photograph the documents or copy posts that you create or any recording of a presentation.

#### **Guidelines**

#### 1. Names

- a. Verbal communication use first names only.
- b. Written communication (e.g. email, flyers, bulletin boards, etc.) use initials only.
- 2. <u>Locations</u>. Use continents or regions when referring to the place where an IW serves; never use specific countries or cities.
- 3. <u>Photos</u>. Never share photos of CAC workers or their family. Respect the threat of facial recognition software. Obscure faces and scenery (e.g. signs, familiar landmarks, etc.).
- 4. Recording. If you record your worship services and post the audio online, please either a) edit out the portion where the CAC worker is referred to or b) turn off the recording during that time, or c) let the CAC worker know it's being recorded.
- 5. <u>Documents</u>. Any written material containing information or reference to CAC workers should be shredded and discarded rather than simply being recycled or thrown in the trash.
- 6. <u>Digital communication</u>. Take special care with all digital/electronic communication, especially emails. Nearly everything online today can be "crawled" by Internet search engine bots, including emails. This is an automated process that constantly searches Internet sites for information found in the following locations:
  - a. Church websites / online storage sites even files in a storage site not visible to the public (e.g. Google Docs, Dropbox, etc.).
  - b. Social media even private/secret/closed groups/private profiles can be detected.
  - c. Emails yes, even private emails can be crawled for data.
  - d. All electronic, cloud-based, or web-based communication.

#### **Correspondence Guidelines**

There are many "searchable" words and subjects that should not be used when communicating with our CAC IWs. The following guidelines are designed to assist you in <u>all</u> your communication with them. The single most important communication mode requiring great discretion is that of <u>email</u>. You must assume that all email sent to and from an IW is downloaded, opened and/or saved by someone in addition to the intended recipient. This alone is reason for caution and vigilance.

- 1. That said, do feel free to write emails and letters to IWs. Mail is a cherished and needed encouragement. Even if you're not able to say all you'd like, please do write.
- 2. From your end never use a mailing or an email address that is associated with a church or a district. Use your personal address only.
- 3. Do not send letters on church stationery. Do not send packages with church return labels.
- 4. Do not send bulletins, Christian magazines, Bibles, church/district newsletters, etc.
- 5. Encrypting emails may bring unwanted attention for the sender and receiver. Use with discretion and only if the IW approves.
- 6. Never send an email to a CAC IW as part of a bulk mailing.

- 7. Use the worker's cues for proper language. When in doubt, err on the side of caution. Avoid words like prayer, church, Jesus, Bible, disciples, etc.
- 8. The C&MA does send missionaries; however, in CACs their identity is often that of a teacher, a businessperson, a medical professional, a development worker, a consultant or other professional. Removing the title "missionary" does not remove their overall purpose. They continue to share Christ with others, disciple new believers, and help to form communities of faith that network with each other. So, we're asking you to never mention missions, missions' activity, evangelism, witnessing, giving out Bibles, the host country's church, support raising, etc.
- 9. Do not mention the worker's host country friends by name or in any way identify them as being interested in Jesus.

These guidelines should be followed for all emails, snail mail, packages and phone calls.
