

# **Scripture Memorization: Accreditation**

#### Word of God

- Inspiration- the words of Scripture are Godbreathed and God's Spirit carried along human authors to write down what God wanted
  - $\rightarrow$  2 Timothy 3:16
  - → 2 Peter 1:20-21
  - → Hebrews 4:12
- Inerrancy- the words of Scripture are without error in the original manuscripts; God's word does not affirm anything contrary to fact; every word is perfect, trustworthy and true
  - → Psalm 12:6; 18:30; 19:7; 119:142
  - → John 17:17
- Illumination- through the aid of the Holy Spirit, believers are able to understand Scripture and are reminded of that which Jesus uttered
  - → John 14:26; 16:13-15
  - → 1 Corinthians 2:11-16

### Person of God

- Attributes- Scripture reveals the characteristics and character traits of God, e.g.
  - → All-knowing, all-present, all-powerful-Psalm 139:1-16
  - → "God is" statements:

    Spirit- John 4:24; consuming fireHebrews 12:29; Light- 1 John 1:5;
    Love- 1 John 4:8,16
  - → Eternal- Psalm 90:1-2
  - → Jealous, avenging, wrathful- Nahum 1:2
  - → Slow to anger, great in power- Nahum 1:3
  - → Good- Nahum 1:7; Luke 18:19
  - $\rightarrow$  Holy- 1 Peter 1:15-16
  - → AND MORE!
- One God in Three Persons (Trinity)- co-eternal, co-equal, co-existing persons, yet one God
  - → One God- Deuteronomy 6:4; James 2:19
  - → Three persons- Genesis 1:26; Isaiah 6:8; Matthew 3:16-17; 28:19; 1 Peter 1:2

#### **Person of Jesus Christ**

- Fully God, Fully Man- the dual nature of Jesus is revealed in Scripture and essential for the proper understanding of his work and purpose
  - → Fully God (deity)- John 1:1; Philippians 2:6; Colossians 1:15-17; 2:9; Hebrews 1:3
  - → Fully man (humanity)- Mark 4:38; Luke 1:30-35; 2:52; John 1:14; 11:35; 19:28
- Past Work- lived a sinless life, revealed God and his kingdom, died as a sacrifice, and rose again to secure salvation for those who believe
  - → Atonement- taking away God's wrath and providing forgiveness by his sacrifice-Romans 3:25; Hebrews 10:10-18; 1 Jn. 2:2
  - → Came to seek and save- Luke 19:10
  - → Showing/proclaiming kingdom- Luke 4:43
- Present and Future Work- Jesus indwells us through his Spirit and is our Savior, Sanctifier, Healer, and Coming King
  - → Indwelling Christ- Galatians 2:20; Philippians 1:21; Colossians 1:27
  - → Savior- Acts 4:12
  - → Sanctifier- 1 Corinthians 1:30
  - → Healer- Isaiah 53:4-5; Matthew 8:14-17
  - → Coming King- Acts 1:11

## Person of the Holy Spirit

- Person and divinity- The Holy Spirit is one of the three persons of God, but he is personal
  - → Divinity- Acts 5:3-4; Romans 8:9
  - → Personal- Ephesians 4:30; 1 Thess. 5:19
- Work in believers-
  - → Comforter, helper, illuminator- John 14:16-17, 26; 16:13-15; Romans 8:14-16, 26-27
  - → Empowerer- Acts 1:8
  - → Gives fruit- Galatians 5:22-23
  - → Gives gifts- Romans 12:4-8; 1 Corinthians 12
- Work in unbelievers-
  - → Conviction- John 16:8-11

## Salvation

- Need- people are created in God's image, yet are fallen in sin; they are in need of salvation
  - → Sinful- Romans 3:10-23
  - → Born sinners- Psalm 51:5
  - → Under wrath- Ephesians 2:1-3
  - → Without excuse- Romans 1:18-20
- Means- only through God's grace through faith in Jesus' work on the cross can people be saved
  - → By grace through faith- Ephesians 2:8-9
  - → Receive Christ- John 1:12-13
  - → Repent and believe- Mark 1:15
  - → Believe and confess- Romans 10:9-10

#### Results-

- → Justification- we are declared not guilty but righteous- Romans 5:1
- → Regeneration- to be made alive, to be made new- John 3:3,5; 2 Corinthians 5:17

### Sanctification

- Decisive/Progressive- sanctification is being set apart to God, becoming more like Jesus; this is both a decisive and progressive experience
  - → Be set apart/holy- 1 Peter 1:15-16
  - → Become more like Jesus- Romans 8:29
  - → Decisive surrender- Romans 6:6-14; 12:1-2
  - → Progressive- 2 Corinthians 3:18; 2 Peter 3:18; 1 John 2:6
  - → Whole person- 1 Thessalonians 5:23-24
- <u>Baptism/Filling- believers are positionally sealed in Christ and live that out by the Spirit</u>
  - → Positional Sanctification/Baptism of the Spirit 1 Corinthians 1:2; 12:13
  - → Experiential Sanctification/Filling of the Spirit Ephesians 5:18
- > Evidence of the Sanctified life-
  - → Fruit of Spirit- Galatians 5:22-23
  - → Transformation- 2 Corinthians 3:18
  - → Empowered service- Acts 1:8

### Church

- Definition/Metaphors- the church is the 'called out' people of God serving his purpose on earth
  - → Description- Acts 2:42-47
  - → Body of Christ- 1 Corinthians 12:12-26; Colossians 1:18
  - → Bride of Christ- Ephesians 5:31-32; Revelation 19:7-9
  - → Branches- John 15:1-8

# Purposes/Ordinances

- → Worship- Colossians 3:16-17
- → Fellowship- Hebrews 10:24-25
- → Giving- 2 Corinthians 8-9
- → Serving- 1 Peter 4:9-11
- → Equipping/Maturing- Ephesians 4:11-16
- → Ordinances-
  - Baptism- Matthew 28:19; Acts 2:38-41
  - Communion- 1 Corinthians 11:23-26

# Mission-

→ Fulfilling the Great Commission, making disciples of the nations and seeing the church mobilized and multiplied in the world- Matthew 28:18-20; Acts 1:8

#### Healing

- > Biblical basis and procedure-
  - → Biblical basis- healing is provided for in the atoning work of Christ- Isaiah 53:4-5; Matthew 8:14-17
  - → Procedure- call the elders- James 5:14-16

#### **End Times**

- Jesus' return- Jesus will come again just as he said he would
  - → 2<sup>nd</sup> coming- Matthew 16:27; Acts 1:11
  - → Imminence (soon)- Matthew 24:36-39, 44
  - → Judgments
    - Judgment seat of Christ (for believers)not for eternal destiny, but rewards- 1 Corinthians 3:10-15; 2 Corinthians 5:10
    - Great white throne (for unbelievers)- for eternal destiny in hell- Revelation 20:11-15 Hell is eternal, conscious torment-Matthew 13:49-50; Revelation 14:11
